

ARE YOU READY FOR ALL HAZARDS?

The All-Hazard Individual and Neighbourhood Emergency Preparedness Workbook identifies many of the hazards in British Columbia and takes you through preparing your family for a variety of disasters such as an earthquake, flood, severe storm, hazardous material spill, forest fire and landslide.

The workbook provides critical information about how to prepare a family emergency plan, conduct a home hazard hunt, respond in an emergency evacuation situation, and prepare and maintain emergency supply kits. It also identifies safety tips for the elderly and/or disabled, actions to take during various emergencies, and how to address children's needs after a disaster.

The workbook was designed and developed to help you protect your family and property. It's downloadable so that B.C. households have the opportunity to fill in the blanks with family information such as employment contact numbers, vehicle registration and bank account numbers, personal medical information, and insurance policy numbers.

By filling in the blanks, you create an individual emergency resource for your household. Keep this resource handy for emergency use and update it regularly.
