Traffic control north of Fort St. John and south of Fort Nelson, near Pink Mountain has been lifted.

If visibility becomes limited due to smoke from the wildfires, pilot vehicles are on sight to escort the travelling public on the Alaska Highway.

Drivers are asked to exercise caution, obey signage and directions from flag persons.
