RESIDENTIAL FLOOD

On 15 Oct, Red Cross representatives responded to provide personal disaster assistance for two residents after a water pipe rupture flooded their mobile home in Kamloops and left them without power. The victims were provided with accommodation and food until power was restored and repairs completed.

BODY RECOVERY

On 15 Oct 02, Penticton SAR members responded to recover the body of a deceased male who had fallen off the Kettle Valley Railway Trestle.

On 16 Oct 02, Coquitlam SAR members responded to the Colony Farm area to recover a body from the Coquitlam River.

On 20 Oct 02, Kamloops SAR responded at the request of the Coroner to retrieve the body of a deceased occupant from a motor vehicle over a 600 meter embankment on Red Lake Road.

On 20 Oct 02, Ridge Meadows SAR responded to recovery of a body from Golden Ears Park.
