SAR teams conducted extensive searches of the downtown, local shopping malls and residential areas of Kamloops as well as the Peterson Creek and Upper Sahali area without success. On 06 Jan 04 the female was located, deceased, near the banks of the Thompson River and her body was recovered for the Coroner.

The patient was airlifted by helicopter and transferred to BCAS at Clearwater for transport to Kamloops Hospital where he received medical treatment.

Due to location and terrain features, a helicopter was authorized to transport SAR teams into the area. The Whistler ice-climbing team were placed on standby but not activated. SAR members provided lighting for a 442 Sqn Cormorant helicopter which utilized a high angle rescue to retrieve the subject from the area for transport to hospital.
