FLOOD

On 12 May financial assistance was provided to cover costs associated with the removal of debris in the Douglas Corridor between Mount Currie and Port Douglas in order to reduce the potential for flooding of the Lillooet River. The costs associated with the clean up and mitigation work will subsequently be recovered from Indian and Northern Affairs Canada.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 10 May Personal Disaster Assistance was required for a parent and child when they were denied access to their rental unit by the police in Maple Ridge. The main floor unit in the house was the scene of a crime and the police had sealed the entire building while conducting their investigation.

On 15 May a town house complex in Richmond was evacuated when one of the residents engaged in an armed stand off with police. A reception centre was set up to accommodate the residents of the complex until the situation was defused and it was safe for them to return to their homes.
