WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 07 June – 13 June 2004

BODY RECOVERY:

On 07 June, Ministry of Transportation, Transport Canada Safety Board, the Airport Authority and the Coroner's office assisted in the recovery of the body of a pilot whose plane crashed into a swamp at the north end of the Prince George Airport.

POWER OUTAGE:

On 07 June, due to a power outage, an emergency generator was supplied to Douglas First Nation Reserve in the Lillooet River area.

FLOOD:

On 10 June, heavy rainfall threatened to flood several homes 26 km east of Princeton. The Princeton Emergency Coordinator and Ministry of Water Land and Air Protection, Water Management responded. Upon investigation it was determined that Litcoola Creek had overflowed down a mountainside and covered the Old Hedley Road, with water and debris however no residences were impacted. Ministry of Highways was contacted to clean up the debris.

EVIDENCE SEARCH:

On 11 June, RCMP request the assistance of the Surrey SAR team to search for evidence in a residential area of Surrey.
