**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 05 July – 11 July 2004**

**DEBRIS FLOW**

On 7 Jul 2004, a debris flow in the Catiline Creek south of Pemberton caused damage to the bridge at In-Shuch-ch Forest Service Road. The road was closed while a BC Forest Service crew worked to clear the debris. The bridge was reopened to traffic by 7:00 PM that evening.

**EVIDENCE SEARCH**

On 5 July 2004, Ridge Meadows SAR team responded to assist RCMP with an evidence search in the Maple Ridge area.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

On 6 July 2004, trees and power lines were downed by heavy winds from a storm that passed through the Sooke area. The Sooke Emergency Coordinator arranged for an arborist to conduct a long term risk assessment.

On 09 July 2004, Indian Northern Affairs Canada approved the acquisition of a back up generator for the community of Douglas First Nations to replace their failing generator.
