WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 26 July – 01 Aug 2004

URBAN INTERFACE FIRE

On 26 Jul 04, Office of the Fire Commissioner issued an evacuation alert for the Charlotte Lake area near Tweedsmuir Park. The incident, originally starting on the 24 July eventually escalated to cover the area from Anahim Lake to Kleena Kleene. ESS Representatives opened a reception centre in Nimpo Lake for 60 residents on Evacuation Order from the Charlotte Lake area. An additional 67 residents on Evacuation Alert from the Anahim Lake/Nimpo Lake area were pre-evacuated to a reception centre in Williams Lake. Representatives from INAC, Ministry of Forests, Ministry of Human Resources, Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Fisheries, Office of the Fire Commissioner and the Provincial Emergency Program continue to monitor the situation and provide assistance to local authorities.

On 27 July 04, a situation on Mt Waddington resulted in the Regional Manager issuing a task and ASE number to rescue an injured hiker.

On July 28 04 Logan Lake Emergency Coordinator provided the Logan Lake Fire Department with replenishment while they were fighting a grass fire.

On 26 Jul 04, 8 Vernon SAR members responded on a humanitarian rescue of a dog stranded on a ledge at Wilsey Dam, Shuswap Falls. 3 Camera Crew members that were shooting a promo video for the SAR team accompanied the team and videotaped the successful rescue.
