**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 6 Sep to 12 Sep 2004**

**DANGEROUS GOODS CODE 2**

On 07 Sept 04 the Office of the Fire Commissioner issued an evacuation order for the residential area surrounding Coglin Road at Davies in Fruitvale after a construction crew inadvertently broke a gas main. The Water Land and Air Protection Response Officer raised the incident to code 2 (urgent) status due to the threat to public safety. The Fruitvale Emergency Program Coordinator responded with Emergency Social Services volunteers and a reception centre was opened at the community centre to receive an estimated 100 displaced residents. Terasen Gas crews repaired the line and restored service to the area, subsequently allowing the residents to safely return to their homes.
