SAR members assisted with extrication of the lone vehicle occupant who was turned over to a waiting ambulance for transport to hospital. |

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 23 Sept 2004, Quesnel SAR members responded to assist RCMP to conduct an evidence search on an island in the Fraser River.

BODY RECOVERY

On 23 Sept 2004, Central Fraser Valley SAR members responded to recover a body from Mill Lake in Abbotsford. The body was turned over to Abbotsford Police and the Coroner.

SNOW STORM

On 20 Sept 2004, heavy snowfall was reported to have occurred over a three day period from 17 to the 19 of September in the Peace River area, from Pink Mountain to Dawson Creek and over to Chetwynd. Snowfall estimates of 10 - 15 inches were reported in various locations. The snow was wet and heavy and resulted in downed power lines, crop damage and an increased potential for slide activity in parts of the region. The Halfway River and other tributaries continue to be monitored for high water levels and potential flooding impacts to homeowners and infrastructure.
