AIR CRASH

On 16 Oct 04, Cranbrook SAR members responded to Moyie Lake following report of a plane crash. The pilot was able to exit the plane before it submerged and he was rescued uninjured.

FLOOD

On 14 Oct 04, heavy rain caused a bridge to wash out and the road to flood on the Nisga'a Highway cutting off the communities of Laxgolts'ap (Greenville) and Kincolith,. Residents in these communities were also without power. Ministry of Transportation responded to the area to assess the damage to the road and bridge. Representatives from BC Hydro, MoT and PEP were advised and monitored the situation.

On 14 Oct 04 heavy rain caused the Kalum River to flood and impact residents in the Dutch Valley near Terrace. Sand was delivered to the residents. PEP RM monitored the situation closely.
