Parks Canada personnel and RCMP Dog Teams also assisted in searching. The missing individual was not located and the SAR members were stood down on 09 Nov.

WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 08 – 14 November 2004

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 09 Nov 04, a natural gas service line to a single residence ruptured and threatened 20 homes in Esquimalt. The Ministry of Water Land and Air Protection (WLAP) Response Officer elevated the incident to Code 2 (Urgent) status due to the potential threat of explosion. An Emergency Social Services member was contacted to assist local response agencies to prepare for the possible evacuation of residents in the vicinity. The evacuation was not required as a response crew from Terasen Gas capped the line and stopped the leak.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 12 Nov 04, Mission and Ridge Meadows SAR members responded to assist RCMP to search for evidence in the Athey Road area.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 09 Nov 04, 50 residents were evacuated from their homes in Merritt while the RCMP apprehended an armed suspect. Emergency Social Services staff responded and a reception centre was established at the Civic Centre to assist displaced residents until they were able to return home.
