WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 22 – 28 Nov 2004

FLOOD

On 24 November 2004, heavy rainfall caused the Chilliwack River to rise and breach the dyke at Chilliwack Lake Road in Hatzic. Several homes and roads in the area were affected by the flood waters. Staff from the Flood Hazard Management Section responded in conjunction with Ministry of Transportation. The Southwest Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centre activated to support the Fraser Valley Regional District in their response.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 23 November 2004, the Surrey SAR team responded to assist Delta RCMP with an evidence search in the vicinity of Nicholson and Scott Roads.
