## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 10 Jan to 16 Jan 2005**

### **FLOOD**

On 10 Jan 05, an ice jam developed on the Bulkley River near Smithers. The Regional District of Bulkley Nechako and the Town of Smithers opened a joint EOC. Representatives from Ministry of Water Lands and Air Protection Water Management, Emergency Social Services, Fire Department, Search and Rescue and PEP Management responded and monitored the situation until the threat was reduced. The Regional District and Town of Smithers continue to monitor the situation.

On 13 Jan, 2005 a potential threat from ice blockage developed at the confluence of the Nechako and Fraser rivers in Prince George. Representatives from Ministry of Water Land and Air Protection Water Management, City of Prince George and PEP Management continue to monitor the situation.

### **LANDSLIDE:**

On 11 Jan, 2005 an EOC was activated in response to a potential landslide on Knox Mountain in Kelowna. ESS set up a reception centre for impacted residents. Representatives from the City of Kelowna continue to monitor the situation.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 10 Jan, 2005, a Reception Centre was set up for residents impacted by a power outage on the North end of Galiano Island.

On 15 Jan, 2005 a Reception Centre was set up at the Fire Hall in Riondel following a power outage. Ambulance Service transported several citizens to the Centre as they required the use of the Fire Department's generator to run their portable oxygen machines.
