They were successfully rescued and were cold and tired, but otherwise uninjured.

RCC dispatched a Buffalo and a Cormorant from Comox. Just prior to the ground SAR members arriving by snowmobile, the 442 Squadron SAR Techs were dropped into the area by the Buffalo. The snowmobiler was stabilized and then airlifted out by the Cormorant. The individual was transported by Cormorant to the Fort St. John airport, and transported to hospital by BCAS.
