On 18 Feb, the deceased snowmobiler was located under the ice approximately 2 miles from where the snowmobile had been located. His body was recovered and turned over to the Coroner. |

After numerous searches up and down the river failed to locate the child, the RCMP stood down the search. |

WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 14 - 20 Feb 2005

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 18 Feb 05, a tanker truck carrying 20,000 litres of gasoline and 5,000 litres of diesel overturned on Turner Road at Uplands in Nanaimo. Gasoline was leaking from a vent. The incident was elevated to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Water Land and Air Protection Response Officer. The City of Nanaimo activated an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC). Due to the potential threat of explosion, the immediate area was evacuated until response personnel were able to off-load the fuel and upright the tanker.

FLOOD

On 14 Feb 05, a number of residential homes and properties in Houston were impacted by flood waters as a result of a frozen blocked culvert. Ministry of Transportation crews responded to clear the culvert and ditch to enable drainage.

On 20 Feb 05, five homes in the Telkwa area were threatened with flooding due to an ice jam that caused the Bulkley River to overflow it's banks. Sandbags and a load of sand were brought in for residents to construct dykes in an attempt to protect their homes. The Bulkley Nechako Regional District, Ministry of Transportation Road Maintenance Contractor and Water Land and Air Protection personnel responded. Residents were encouraged to voluntarily evacuate and an Emergency Social Services volunteer from Smithers established a reception centre at the Telkwa Village Hall to receive potential evacuees.

MISCELANEOUS

On 19 Feb 05, one night's accommodation was provided for a handicapped individual in Coquitlam who was flooded out of his apartment following a water line break in the apartment above him.
