**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 21 Mar to 27 Mar 2005**

**DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 22 March 05, the post office in Golden was evacuated and 11 people were sent to hospital as a result of someone spraying a caustic material into the intake of the ventilation system. The incident was made Code 2 (urgent status) by the Water Land and Air Protection Response Officer. The area was treated as a crime scene and the Director of Occupational Environmental Risk Management from the Federal Government assumed the role of the lead response agency. As the lead agency, testing was done and nothing in the air was abnormal (air readings were fine). They additionally reported deposited material had finished reacting and had stabilized. Air and swab samples collected are to be analyzed to identify the material. Cleanup crews removed contaminated floor tiles and washed down other areas.

**EVIDENCE SEARCH**

On 24 March 05, Rossland and Castlegar SAR teams conducted an evidence search between Nancy Green Junction and the Paulson Bridge.

On 27 March 05, Vernon SAR conducted an evidence search on the west side of Okanagan Lake.
