MISCELLANEOUS

On 11 April, the Kamloops police ordered an evacuation of 10 households due to an armed standoff. Emergency Social Services responded to provide 5 families, totaling 19 individuals with accommodation and a meal for one night.

TERRORISM

On 12 April, the RCMP "E" Division reported a white powder incident at the Surrey Taxation Centre. The building was evacuated and the Fire Department HAZMAT team and RCMP Chemical Biological Radiological and Nuclear (CBRN) Unit responded. The incident was closed when the substance was analyzed and determined to be baking powder.
