## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 25 Apr – 01 May 2005**

### **ENVIRONMENT**

On 27 April 05 a landslide occurred approximately 60 metres east of the Johnston Street Bridge into the Quesnel River in Quesnel. The bank sloughed off into the river and pulled the sewer lines for approximately 150 homes into the river with it. The impact to the community was significant and on 29 April the local government declared a State of Local Emergency in order to evacuate the homes within the impacted area.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 29 Apr 05, Lillooet Rescue responded to a report of an individual trapped under a trailer. Rescue personnel stabilized the trailer, loaded the individual onto a stretcher and he was then transported to hospital by BCAS.
