**EVIDENCE SEARCH**

On 18 Sept 05, the RCMP requested assistance from Duncan/North Cowichan SAR on behalf of the Transportation Safety Board to assist with the search for parts of a downed helicopter in the Koksilah area.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

On 13 Sept 05, the Fire Department evacuated 30 homes in Chilliwack due to toxic fumes emitting from a fire in a meat packing plant. An Emergency Social Services (ESS) volunteer responded to the scene and arranged one night's accommodation for the displaced residents.

On 16 Sept 05, 5 homes were evacuated in Richmond due to a police situation. Emergency Social Services volunteers responded and arranged for a bus to transport impacted residents to the community centre where they remained until it was deemed safe for them to return.
