WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 19 Sept – 25 Sept, 2005

BODY RECOVERY

On 21 Sept 05, Golden SAR responded to recover a body that had been located near the Order of Buffalo campground in the Golden area.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 25 Sept 05, a CP Rail train derailed west of Yahk near the Moyie River. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) when it was determined that two of the twelve rail cars which left the track had spilled potash into standing water near the river. A berm was built up and absorbent pads and silt fencing were put in place to prevent downstream contamination. The MOE RO responded to the scene to take samples and monitor the situation. Environment Canada, PEP Regional Manager, Creston's Emergency Program Coordinator, Ministry of Health, Idaho Emergency Management Organization (EMO), CANUTEC, Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness Canada (PSEPC) were advised of the spill. Alpine Environmental has been contracted to assist with the clean up. The cars will be righted and removed from the area.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 23 Sept 05, Quesnel Highway Rescue responded with extrication tools, to rescue a logger trapped beneath a tree located at km 55 on the 500 Rd.
