WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 26- Sept – 02 Oct, 2005

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 27 Sept 05, a Scamp Transport "B" train carrying 38,000 litres of gasoline was involved in an accident at Yale Road and Guildford in Abbotsford and rolled on its side spilling a large quantity of gasoline which entered the storm system and local watercourses including Marshall Creek. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment (MOE) Response Officer when the Police and Fire Dept assisted by Search and Rescue members from Central Fraser Valley, Surrey and Mission started a precautionary evacuation of over two thousand people from nearby residences, schools and businesses due to the threat of fire and explosion. BC Hydro shut off the power and Terasen Gas shut off the natural gas supply to the area. Office of the Fire Commissioner staff were notified and issued an evacuation order of the area. Emergency Social Services (ESS) responded and set up a reception centre to assist the displaced people. An Incident Command Post (ICP) was set up at the scene to coordinate spill response and MOE staff responded to the scene to provide technical expertise and assistance. Public Works and Fire Dept deployed booms and pads and a vacuum truck was used to remove the collected product. CEDA responded to the scene to oversee the clean up and recovery process. The local government Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) was activated in support of the ICP and the Provincial Emergency Program (PEP) Regional Manager responded to the EOC to provide Emergency Management support. The Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centre (PREOC) and the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre (PECC) were also activated to level 1 in support of local government. Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness Canada, Washington State Emergency Management Operations, Washington State Environmental Protection Agency, Ministry of Transportation, MOE HQ, and Department of Fisheries were notified and monitored the situation.
