WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 11-17 JAN 2010

MISCELLANEOUS

On 13 Jan 2010, the CTL PREOC was activated in support of Dangerous Goods Incident #902662, when a local farmer applied liquid manure to his fields during snow melt conditions. The material contaminated the local municipal drinking water well which impacted 1200 homes. The Health Authority was advised and the community activated their EOC.

On 15 Jan 2010, a resident of Prince George was provided accommodation for one night due to burst pipes in her residence. The elderly lady had no friends or family in the area and suffered from diabetes. The task number was issued due to health reasons.

FLOOD

On 11 Jan 2010, Courtenay EOC was activated in response to localized flooding. Comox Regional District declared a State of Local Emergency and residents were evacuated from the Maple Camp Site Mobile Home Park.

On 12 Jan 2010, flooding occurred at the One Mile Bridge on Highway 99 in Pemberton. Excavators were brought in by the District to remove ice and debris from the river to try and alleviate the problem.

On 13 Jan 2010, flooding occurred in the Coldstream area due to unseasonably warm temperatures.

On 13 Jan 2010, the Central Okanagan Regional District activated their EOC in support of localized flood response.

On 13 Jan 2010, localized flooding in the Vernon area impacted one family.

On 14 Jan 2010, the Regional District of Nanaimo activated their EOC to Level 2 in support of localized flood response along the Nanaimo River.

On 14 Jan 2010, rising waters of the Nanaimo River flooded the access road impacting 16 Snuneymuxw First Nations homes along Raines Road. A Band Council Resolution was issued and displaced residents were provided food and accommodations.

On 14 Jan 2010, the Cowichan Valley Regional District activated their EOC to Level 1 in anticipation of flooding along the Cowichan and Koksilah Rivers.

On 14 Jan 2010, the Strathcona Regional District activated its EOC to Level 1 due to the potential for flooding in the regional district.

On 15 Jan 2010, two homes in the Grand Forks area were impacted by flooding. Sand was brought in and the water was diverted into an adjacent farmer's field.

LANDSLIDE

On 15 Jan 2010, two landslides in the Qualicum Beach area resulted in damage. One landslide caused a house to move off its foundation and the other resulted in a hole in the wall of the building.

On 15 Jan 2010, a landslide closed the In-Shuck-ch Forest Service Road, resulting in several First Nation and non First Nation residents being temporarily displaced. The road was subsequently opened later in the day and most of the residents returned to their homes.
