## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 01 March – 07 March 2010**

### **DANGEROUS GOODS INCIDENT REPORT**

On 03 Mar 10, two CP trains were involved in a head on collision at Casey Junction near Golden. A 1,000 gallon propane tank was ruptured on impact and the resulting flash set a nearby derelict structure on fire. 20 cars containing potash were derailed and one of the three engines was on its side leaking diesel fuel. Anderson Road was blocked by the train for several hours cutting off access to 11 residences. The Ministry of Environment Emergency Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (Urgent Status) due to the proximity of nearby residences. The Fire Department contained the fire, while and CP response crews moved the train to clear the roadway. The locomotives will be removed and remaining clean up will be carried out by CP over the next few days.

### **EVIDENCE SEARCH**

On 04 March 10, Campbell River SAR assisted RCMP with an evidence search in the Campbell River area.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 02 Mar 10, Kamloops SAR members responded to assist with a humanitarian rescue of a dog from a ledge in the area of Chase Creek Water Fall near Chase.
