AIR CRASH

On 18 Apr 10 Salmon Arm Rescue was requested to respond with extrication tools to the Salmon Arm Airport after a float plane failed to clear the fence at the end of the runway. The Regional Manager approved response after it was confirmed by JRCC. The 4 aircraft occupants were able to get out of the plane without assistance and rescue volunteers were stood down.
