WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 03 to 09 May 2010

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 05 May 2010, a number of businesses, residences and Mayfair Shopping Centre were evacuated in Victoria when a gas line was damaged during construction work. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to code 2 (urgent status) due to the evacuations and media attention. Terasen Gas crews responded along with Saanich Fire Rescue. The leak was stopped and the line was repaired and the area was deemed safe for re-entry.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 05 May 2010, Emergency Social Services responded to arrange for one night's accommodation for a family of three adults who were evacuated from their residence during a police investigation.
