**EVIDENCE SEARCH**

On 31 May 2010, RCMP requested assistance from 100 Mile house SAR to conduct an evidence search in the 100 Mile House area. 10 members responded and were stood down by RCMP.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

On 31 May 2010, Cariboo Regional District requested a task number in support of a potential evacuation of 6 homes and an elementary school after a backhoe stuck a gas line in 150 Mile House.
