WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 21 June TO 27 JUNE 2010

BODY RECOVERY

On 21 June 2010, Castlegar SAR responded to assist the RCMP with a body recovery on the Columbia River.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 21 June 2010, Victoria Police requested SAR assistance in searching for evidence in the Saxe Point area of Esquimalt.

FLOOD

On 23 June 2010, the Squamish Lillooet Regional District activated their EOC to monitor and respond to issues that could arise due to high water levels from seasonal freshet and complications from a log jam on the Birkenhead River.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 26 June 2010, a fire next to the Clearwater Hospital caused the evacuation of the hospital and surrounding senior care facilities. Emergency Social Services (ESS) and Wells Gray Search and Rescue (SAR) responded to assist RCMP with the evacuation. Clearwater Secondary School was set up as a temporary reception and care center for patients. The fire was extinguished and those displaced were allowed back to the hospital and senior facilities.
