On 11 July 2010, a fire at the Tolko Sawmill in Spillumcheen outside of Armstrong occurred resulting in the evacuation of residents from several mobile home parks and the relocation of livestock. The Town of Spillumcheen activated their Emergency Operations Centre and a Declaration of a State of Local Emergency was issued.
