WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 19-25 JULY 2010

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 21 Jul 2010, a fuel tanker truck was involved in a motor vehicle incident on the Island Highway near Sayward spilling a portion of its load of gasoline and diesel. The incident was upgraded by the MOE Response Officer to Code 2 Urgent Status. The highway was closed until a truck and trailer unit could be brought in to off-load the product and the Fire Dept foamed the area in preparation for the off-loading procedure. The incident concluded early on 22 July, and the highway was re-opened.

On 21 July 2010, CN train derailment occurred east of Prince George. 14 cars filled with coal were derailed, spilling coal onto the CN rail right of way. No waterways were impacted. Clean-up is underway by CN rail and is estimated to take possibly 2 weeks.

On 21 July 2010, a Super B tanker truck transporting used transformer oil (4.3 ppm PCB) became involved in a motor vehicle incident between Creston and Sirdar on Hwy 3. A fire occurred causing potential toxic smoke from this and burning railway ties. Fire Department conducted a tactical evacuation of 5 - 6 homes in the vicinity. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 Urgent Status. Residents were allowed back into area that evening.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 22 Jul 10, the Squamish Lillooet Regional District (SLRD) activated their EOC to a level 2 due to an interface fire burning in the Yalokom Valley (Fire K70219). The fire started overnight on Jade Mountain Road and two homes were tactically evacuated. An Evacuation Alert was issued for all homes up to the junction of the Yalokom Forest Service Road and Hwy #40. The SLRD declared a State of Local Emergency to help facilitate their response efforts.

On 22 Jul 10, the SWE PREOC was activated in support of local authority response to interface fires within the region.

On 23 July 2010, an interface fire occurred in the North Okanagan Regional District (NORD) on Westside Road on the Reserve (Fire# K40226). This was a result of 4 residences catching fire and spreading to the surrounding forest. Ministry of Forests responded to site.

On 25 July 2010, Central Okanagan Regional District activated their EOC to a level 1 due to an interface fire in Sailview Bay, West Kelowna (Fire# K50237).
