WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 26 July - 01 Aug 2010

DANGEROUS GOODS CODE 2

On 31 Jul 10, fires broke out in an industrial park in Kelowna leading to tactical evacuations of a one square kilometer area. There were several explosions due to a building containing a highly combustible fertilizer. The incident was raised to Code 2 by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer. Central Okanagan Regional District and Interior Health Authority continue to monitor situation due to the fertilizer and other chemicals entering nearby waterways.

AIR CRASH

On 31 Jul 10, a water bomber plane crashed in the Lytton area. Pemberton SAR responded to incident but was stood down en route.

INTERFACE FIRE

The SWE, CTL, NEA and NWE Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centre's (PREOC) and the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre (PECC) in Victoria were activated to provide support to local authorities due to the following Interface Fires

On 28 Jul 10, Municipality of Kamloops activated their EOC (Emergency Operations Centre) in response to Interface Fire (K20255). A Local State of Emergency was declared and an Evacuation Order was declared for 50 residences in the Kamloops Riverview Mobile Home Park. Evacuation Order and Local State of Emergency have been rescinded and residents have been allowed back into area.

On 28 Jul 10, Cariboo Regional District (CRD) activated their EOC in response to Interface Fire (C20189) between Riske Creek and Kersley, Interface Fire (C20210) near 140 Mile and Interface Fire (C50183) near Bull Canyon, 80 km's NW of Alexis Creek. Task #111661. CRD and INAC also monitored Brigham Creek Fire (C20243)

On 28 Jul 10, Thompson Nicola Regional District activated their EOC to in response to Interface Fire (K20262) near Bonaparte Lake. Evacuation Order and a Local State of Emergency were declared on the same day and later rescinded 01 August, 2010.

On 28 Jul 10, City of Burnaby activated their EOC in response to Interface Fire (V10639) on Burnaby Mountain. Fire was controlled quickly and residents returned home.

On 28 Jul 10 Bulkley Nechako Regional District activated their EOC in response to Interface Fire (G40336) near Tatuk Lake

On 28 Jul 10, the PEP Northwest Regional office monitored an interface fire (R90093) 20km south of the Yukon Border because of Hwy 37 from Blue River Junction to Alaska Hwy being closed.

FLOODING

On 30 Jul 10, City of Fort St John activated their EOC in response to flooding caused by heavy rain event causing localized flooding.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 26 Jul 10, Squamish SAR responded to RCMP request to rescue a pet in distress on an island in the middle of the Malquam River. Pet was successfully rescued.
