URBAN INTERFACE FIRES

On 16 Aug the Cariboo Regional District issued an Evacuation Order for a section of Highway 20 that was being impacted by a the Heckman Pass Complex Fire (C50300).

On 16 Aug the Bulkley Nechako Regional District issued an Evacuation Order for the Duck Lake Fire (R20165) burning in the area of Francois Lake. The fire was impacting a mining operation the highway and some power transmission lines.

On 17 Aug, the City of Williams Lake activated their EOC for the Soda Creek Mackenzie Industrial fire associated with the Meldrum Complex Fire (C20189). A Declaration of a State of Local Emergency and an Evacuation Alert were issued.

On 18 Aug, Fraser Fort George Regional District activated their EOC in response to the Pelican Complex Fire (C10299, C10205). A Declaration of a State of Local Emergency and an Evacuation Order were issued.

On 20 Aug, a task was issued in support of INAC for the Central Region.

On 20 Aug, the Lower Similkameen Band activated their EOC to support potential alerts/evacuations and ESS response with regards to the Tweedle Creek Fire.

On 20 Aug, an evacuation order was issued for a lodge in the Bulkley Nechako Regional District near Tetachuck Lake.
