

5.11 VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION PROGRAM

5.11.1 Policy

1. Volunteers in the following five categories; Search and Rescue; PEP Air Service; Communication; Emergency Social Services; and Emergency Program/Area Coordinators will be recognized annually for their service to the Provincial Emergency Program.

5.11.2 Conditions

1. To be eligible for an annual recognition award, volunteers and Emergency Program Coordinators must:
 - a. be registered through PEP;
 - b. have in the past and/or present performed outstanding long service or performed with dedication, personal sacrifice or excellence and distinction; and
 - c. be nominated as a candidate for the annual recognition award. Any PEP recognized person or organization is eligible to submit nominations.

5.11.3 Nomination Procedures

1. The following are the procedures to complete the Attorney General's Annual PEP Volunteer Awards Nomination Form. The following numbers are referenced on the sample form enclosed at Annex D.
 - a. Full name and address of nominee for processing purposes. Please assure that writing is legible. Check to ensure nominee is a registered PEP volunteer.
 - b. Nominee may be enrolled in multiple categories.
 - c. The two people or groups used as references may be of varied origins (e.g., physician, mayor, council member, fire chief, local SAR Manager/Leader).
 - d. Provide brief biographical summary of nominee.
 - e. Full name and address of nominator for processing purposes. Please ensure that writing is legible. Date request form completed.
